**SCHEDULE OLS
Outdoor Lighting Service**

AVAILABILITY

This schedule is available in all territories served by the Cooperative, subject to the established Service Rules and Regulations of the Cooperative.

APPLICABILITY

This schedule is applicable for the purpose of lighting streets, highways, parks and other public places for at locations within or without municipal limits on the Cooperative's distribution system.

MONTHLY RATE

Dusk to dawn outdoor lighting service using one of the Cooperative's standard luminaires mounted with a 30-inch bracket on an existing distribution pole with secondary:

Decorative Lighting Packages Installed After to April 1, 2009

Dusk to dawn outdoor lighting service using one of the Cooperative's standard decorative lighting packages will be provided at a monthly rate of \$10.00 per luminaire, plus an upfront contribution-in-aid of construction equal to the net present value difference between the revenue streams of the decorative fixture installed and the Cooperative's base fixture. Consumers requesting nonstandard decorative lighting packages will be responsible for installing, owning, and maintaining the lighting system. Nonstandard lighting systems will be served by the Cooperative at one location through a standard metered service.

Dusk to dawn outdoor lighting service using one of the Cooperative's standard decorative lighting packages. (Rate does not include underground conductor and an additional charge must be added as shown on below.):

Non-standard poles and luminaires not listed above may be installed, at the Cooperative's option, at the monthly rate shown above for the equivalent wattage and light source plus either a Contribution in Aid of Construction or an extra monthly charge of 2.0% of the difference between the estimated installed cost of the luminaire(s) and structure requested and the estimated installed cost of the equivalent wattage and light source luminaire(s) and comparable pole shown above.

When the installation of underground conductors requires more than normal trenching (i.e. pavement cutting and replacement, rock digging, or duct system) the member shall have the option of paying a Contribution in Aid of Construction or an extra monthly charge of 2.0% of the difference between the estimated extraordinary installation costs and the estimated installation cost for normal trenching.

When two or more luminaires are mounted on the same pole or other structure, the monthly rate shall be that above plus any extra applicable charges shown above less the additional pole charge shown above for each luminaire in excess of one mounted on the pole or structure.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE

1. Luminaires will only be installed on Cooperative owned poles or structures. All facilities necessary for service under this Schedule, including fixtures, lamps, controls, poles, structures, hardware, conductors, and other attachments shall be owned and maintained by the Cooperative.
2. All maintenance, including lamp replacement, will be performed during regular business hours, as soon as possible, following notification by the member.
3. The member shall protect and be responsible for all deliberate or careless damage to the Cooperative's lighting equipment. The Cooperative reserves the right to cancel the luminaire and all property in connection therewith, if such damages occur.
4. The member shall allow authorized representatives of the Cooperative to enter upon the member's property for required maintenance; to trim and cut trees and shrubbery as necessary for maintenance of the lighting equipment; and to remove lighting equipment upon termination of service under this Schedule.
5. Member shall be responsible for all costs to have the light relocated.

TERM

The initial term for service under this Schedule shall be a minimum of three (3) years. Decorative and/or non-standard lights and poles may require longer term contracts. After the original term service may be terminated with 90-day notice. Members terminating service prior to end of the original term shall be responsible for the Cooperative's costs to remove the facilities associated with service under this Schedule.

WHOLESALE POWER COST ADJUSTMENT

The approved Wholesale Power Cost Adjustment applicable to retail service will be applied to all service supplied under this schedule.

RENEWABLE ENERGY PORTFOLIO STANDARD (REPS) ADJUSTMENT

The consumer's monthly bill shall also include a REPS adjustment based upon the revenue classification of the account. The revenue classifications and monthly charges are shown in the Cooperative's Rider REPS.

ENERGY EFFICIENCY RIDER

The Energy Efficiency Rider is also applicable to this rate schedule. The current Energy Efficiency Rider charge applicable to this schedule must be added to the cents per kWh above to determine the monthly energy charges.

TAXES

Any applicable State and Local Sales Taxes will be added to all service billed under this schedule.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

The above rates are net. Bills are due and payable within 25 days of the billing date shown on the bill. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid within 25 days of the billing date, it shall be considered delinquent, and service will be suspended in accordance with the Service Rules and Regulations.
